Essential Data

Minimum information required to fully process a referral:

Patient demographic sheet (including documentation of being a non-smoker)

Copy of insurance card

Prescription (including drug name, dose and frequency)

Pulmonary function tests (including forced expiratory volume in 1 second [FEV1] volume)

Graded exercise test results

Supporting diagnostic test results (including Alpha-1 level, phenotype, arterial blood gas, liver function, computed tomography [CT] scan, x-ray documenting emphysema)

History and physical (including height, weight, allergies, clinical history of emphysema, family history of Alpha-1, treatment history, infection history and hospitalization history, homebound status)

Letter of medical necessity (if available)

Immunology profile, including immunoglobulin A (IgA) level (if applicable)
